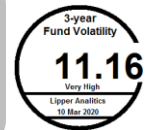




AMANAH SAHAM BANK SIMPANAN NASIONAL (ASBSN)

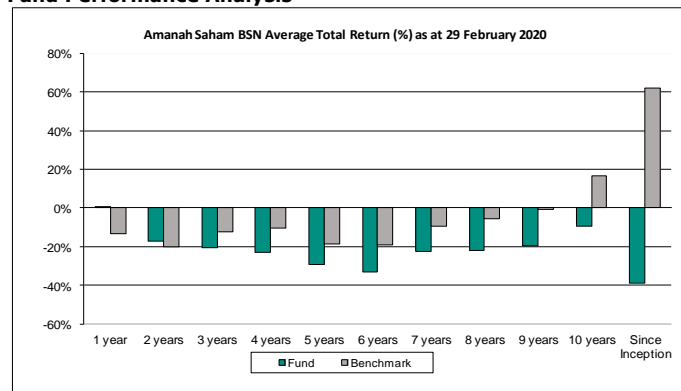
Market Review

Global equity markets experienced a sharp sell-off in February amid rising concerns over the impact of COVID-19 virus on economic activities and global growth. On the local front, weak sentiment from lower-than-expected 4Q19 GDP growth (+3.6% YoY) and unexcited corporate earnings was exacerbated by political turmoil following Tun Mahathir's resignation as Prime Minister and the ruling government lost its Parliamentary majority. The King has later appointed Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin as the 8th Prime Minister of Malaysia but we still do not have cabinet in place in February. A stimulus package worth RM20b was unveiled but FBMKLCI still closed 3.2% lower while FBM Emas Shariah registered a decline of 3.7% in local currency terms in February 2020.

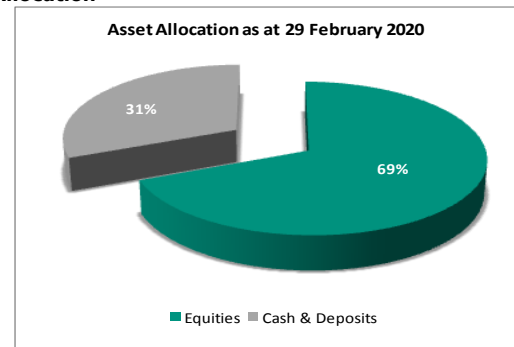

Based on the Fund's portfolio returns as at 10 March 2020, the Volatility Factor (VF) for this Fund is 11.16 and is classified as "Very High". (source: Lipper). "Very High" includes funds with VF that are above 11.065 (source: Lipper). The VF means there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six months. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.
