Fund Objective

**Note: "Attractive dividend" refers to stocks of companies which have provided an average gross dividend of at least 3% for the past 3 years from the latest financial year.

Market Review

FBM KLCI and FBM Shariah Index gained 1.8% and 3.3% respectively in April driven mainly by gains in the healthcare and transport sectors. Meanwhile, the FBM Small Cap Index rose 2.7% in April. Market sentiment was boosted by the approval of the MRT3 project in the Klang Valley, and news that Axiata Group is in "advance discussions" with Telenor Asia to merge the telco operations of Celcom and Digi.Com. However, market fell towards the last week of the month due to concerns over new Covid-19 cases that began to increase in April after hitting the low of 941 cases on 29 March. New cases hit the high of 3,788 on 30 April. Foreign investors were net sellers of RM1.1 billion in April 2021, taking year-to-date net selling to RM2.8 billion. Prices of Brent crude oil and CPO rose 7.1% and 5.8% to RM3,868 per ton and USD67.3 per barrel respectively over the month. FTSE Russell removed Malaysia from the watch list for a potential downgrade and retained its membership in World Government Bond Index. Ringgit strengthened by 1.3% to RM4.088 against USD at the end of April 2021.

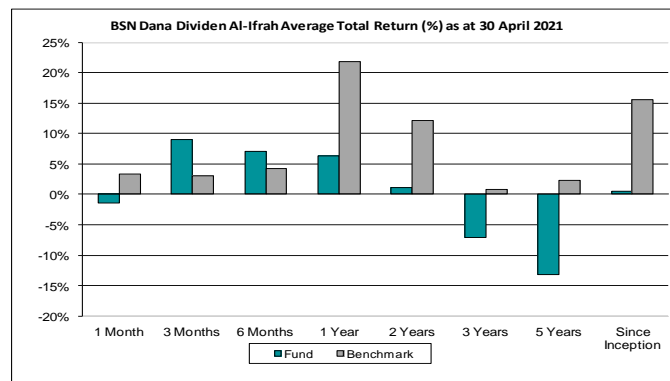
