**Note: "Attractive dividend" refers to stocks of companies which have provided an average gross dividend of at least 3% for the past 3 years from the latest financial year.

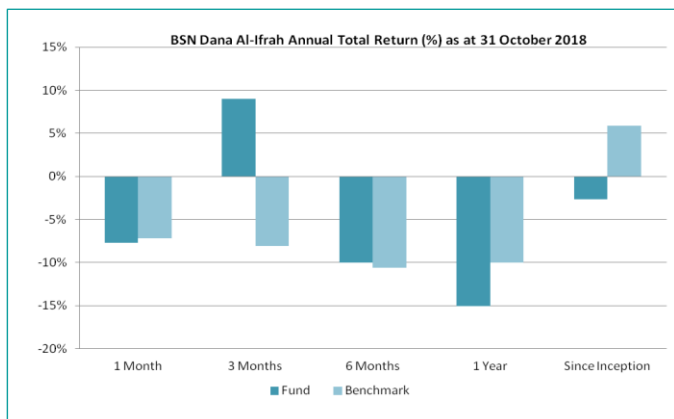
Market Review & Outlook

The KLCI fell 4.7% mom to close at 1,709 points in Oct due to foreign selling and corrections in the US and regional markets. The KLCI fell as much as 110 points to a low of 1,683.06 points during the month of October. However, a recovery in sentiment pushed the index up by 23 points on the last day of October to close at 1,709 points. It was also the worst October performance for KLCI since 2008, when it plunged 15.2% mom. As a result, KLCI's YTD losses widened to 5%.

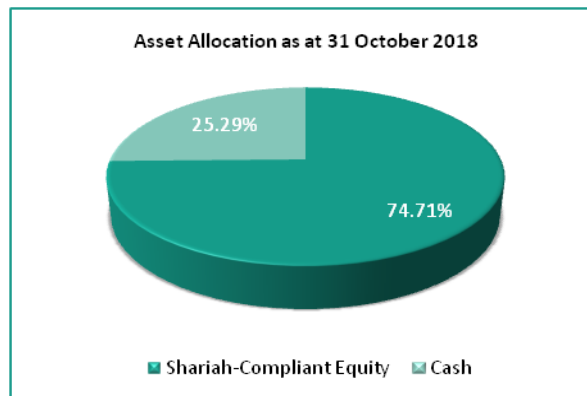
