Fund Objective

The investment objectives of ASBSN are to seek medium to long term capital appreciation of the Units through investment in the equity markets and to seek income opportunities by investing in high income yielding securities and interest-bearing instruments.

Market Review

The FBMKLCI declined by 0.5% mom, closing at 1,594 due to profit taking by foreign investors likely driven by concerns over the potential escalation of trade tensions stemming from tariff threats by US President, rising tensions in the Middle East, and an underwhelming 3Q earnings season. Healthcare was the best performing sector, gaining 5.3%. Telcom, on the other hand, was the worst performing sector, losing 3.1%.

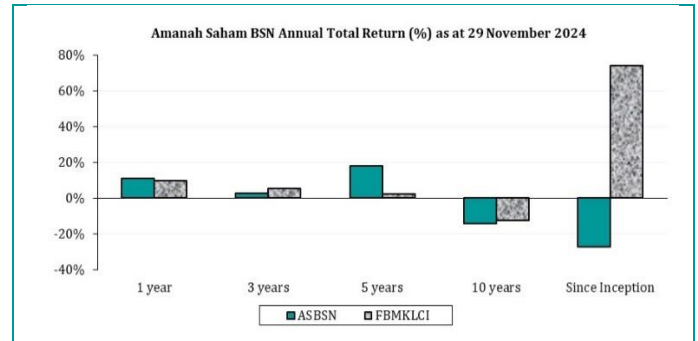
